Reflection



In his interaction with the Samaritan Woman, Jesus teaches us the power of interpersonal communication and evangelization. He appeared as an ordinary man in an ordinary place and began by asking the woman for ordinary water before he spoke to her about extraordinary water. Even though he was a Jew, he deliberately approached the Samaritan Woman and requested for water. He intended to break the walls that separated Jews from Samaritans and build a bridge of interaction between this separated people.

Despite her sinfulness Jesus used her as an instrument for the conversion of her people. God is very fond of people who are weak, the least, the outcast, and people who are despised and he uses them to perform mighty works. God chose all kinds of people through the ages, he chose Abraham despite his old age, he worked with Noah even when he had a problem with alcohol, he chose Rahab who was a prostitute, Samson who was a womanizer, he chose David and Jeremiah even when they were too young, he chose Peter who denied him, he chose Zacchaeus not minding that he was a very short man, he chose the twelve apostles even though they were not from royal or rich families. This is the reason why Jesus declares: I have not come for the righteous but for sinners (Mark 2:17; Luke 5:32). He chooses us not for what we are but for what he can make out of us; he chooses ordinary people and makes them extraordinary.

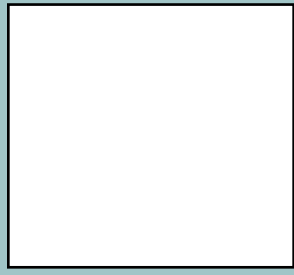
