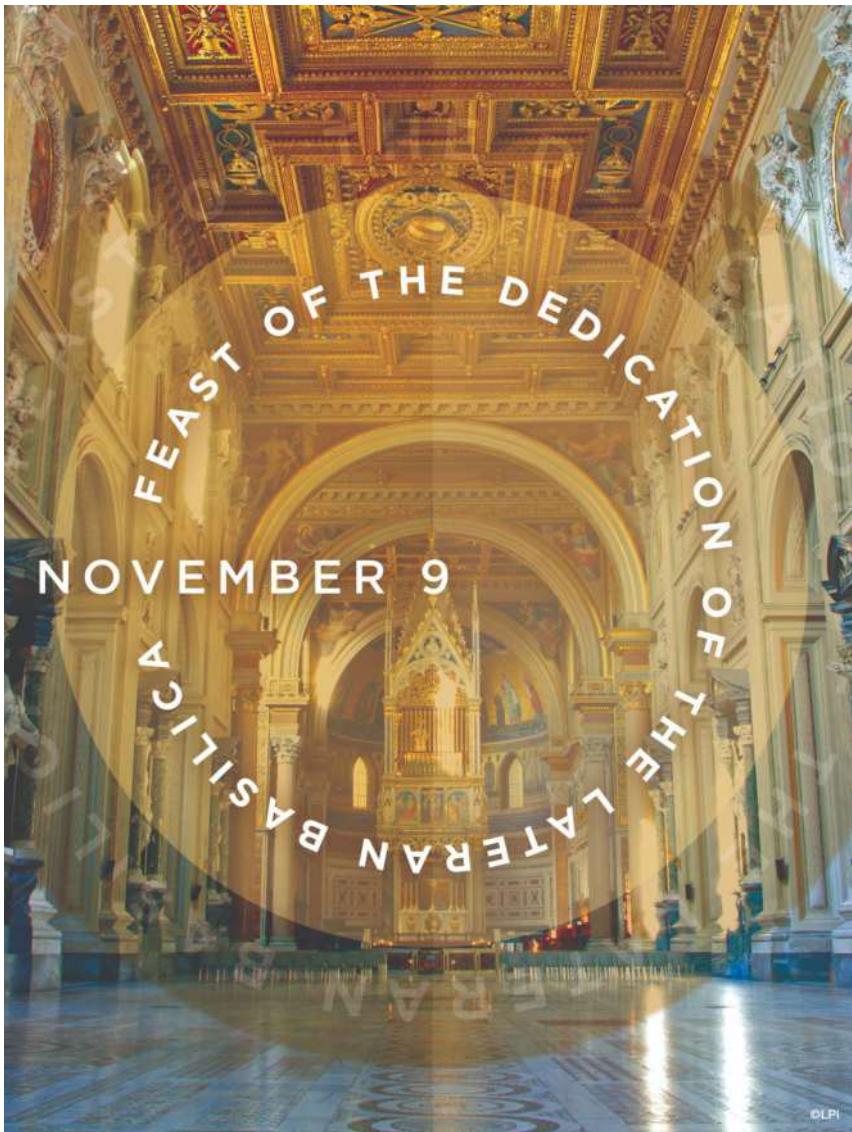

Did you know there are churches in Rome older than St. Peter's? St. John Lateran is one of four major basilicas in the Eternal City, and it is by far the oldest. The land was donated by an ancient Roman family to the Emperor Constantine, who in turn gave it to the Church. For hundreds of years, St. John Lateran was the "mother church." Popes lived on the grounds through the 14th century. The church itself suffered from pillaging by invaders, fires, and earthquakes. It has been restored and rebuilt five times since the 300s. On this feast, we remember more than a building. We celebrate the resiliency of our faith. Though trials may come in our parishes, personal lives, and the world, the Church endures through the grace of Jesus Christ.

Holy Spirit Family of Parishes Communications Update

Update on our progress on improving communications in our family of parishes.

In response to parishioner requests, in July, the Leadership team worked with parish representatives at each parish site to prepare a Communications talk after mass. Afterwards, a questionnaire was providing asking for suggestions.

Summary

29 parishioners completed the questionnaire. Others made suggestions directly to presenters or leadership team members at each parish. While some suggestions were the same, there were 30 unique recommendations for improvement

11 additional suggestions were “things we should keep doing”

What We Are Doing

During mass, priests should try and “connect” by making eye contact, speaking louder, slower

Fr. Francis should share with Music lead, which songs he plans to sing during sermon

Announcements of funeral masses via robo calls, One Call, and bulletin

Review and modify the design of the bulletin – Weekly Calendar section, easier to read, better use of space

Include a “From the pastor” section in the bulletin

Ring of the bells during consecration

Update parish websites

Make another request from parishioners to be included in One Call or Robo Calls

Make written communications easier to understand

Longer Notice for meetings, events – (at least 1-2 weeks before event)

Additional notice of events other than bulletin (example, flyers for Together Sunday)

Provide available office hours

Announce souls to be prayed for during mass

Make announcements at Saturday Masses

What We Are Working On

Reach out to Bereavement Committee –so all are aware of funeral masses

Spoke with staff to be available; Respond within 24 hours to office calls

Improve accuracy of information in bulletins

Prayer Chain – ask anyone who wants to be included to fill out card

More updates on BOL

Leadership list on websites (Pastor, staff; Pastoral Council, Finance and Leadership)

Using email in addition to other communication tools

Heat/air at church sites

Can Be Initiated by Parishioners

Rosary after each mass

Providing snacks at meetings

Asking priests for special intentions at mass

Ushers can direct people to closer seats at masses

Things That Are Working Well

Good and loving priest, deacons, staff and parishioners

Availability of priests after masses – talking with parishioners

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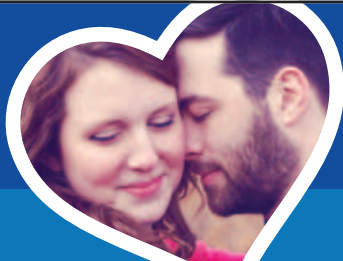
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
