





## From the Pastor's Desk

### Executive Summary

**Holy Spirit Family of Parishes Unity Discernment Day (Reflection & Assessment)**

**Location: St. Benedict the Moor Church Multipurpose Room**

**Presented: February 21, 2026**

### Introduction

This executive summary provides an in-depth assessment of the current state and future direction of the Holy Spirit Family of Parishes, as presented to the congregation and leadership at St. Benedict the Moor Church Location. The summary synthesizes responses to key reflection questions to support ongoing discernment and planning within the Beacons of Light initiative and the broader mission of sharing the Gospel in our archdiocese.

### 1. Vision and Mission Alignment

The Holy Spirit Family of Parishes articulates its vision as:

*"We, the members of the Holy Spirit Family of Parishes, will foster discipleship by making the Eucharist the center of our lives as we form, live, and share our faith."*

This vision is rooted in discipleship and stewardship, focusing on living out the Gospel through daily life and community. It supports the God-given mission of evangelization by emphasizing not only personal faith but also the invitation to bring others into a Christ-centered life. The vision is not just aspirational—it is actively embodied in parish life, community engagement, and outreach, demonstrating a strong alignment with the archdiocesan mission.

### 2. Mission Planning Progress

The Family of Parishes has not yet completed Phase 4 of the Mission Plan. This is a recognized area for further development, with future goals, objectives, and action items to be established collaboratively.

### 3. Financial Assessment

#### a. Revenue, Expenses, and Savings:

The Family is financially solvent. Some parishes rely on savings rather than ongoing giving, but all have at least 3–6 months of operating expenses in reserve.

#### b. Giving by Age Group:

There is a significant reliance on parishioners aged 70 and older for financial support (ranging from 27% to 63% across parishes). Demographic trends indicate an aging population, with the proportion of older adults increasing and younger age groups declining. This presents a risk for future giving unless parishioner numbers increase and engagement broadens to younger demographics.

#### c. Giving per Household:

Current giving averages 1.24% of registered households' income—below the archdiocesan average—indicating clear potential to increase stewardship. There are also concerns that some

### 4. Church Utilization and Mass Coverage

The Family's churches are underutilized; weekend Mass attendance at each site is well below 50% of capacity. While two priests can cover the required Masses, could reducing the number of Masses consolidate attendance, making services more vibrant, and better align with archdiocesan parameters?

### 5. Benefits of Unification and Collaboration

The most notable benefit of forming a Family of Parishes has been a genuine sense of unity and shared purpose, with collaborative councils and leadership teams. Shared staffing and a unified bulletin have already reduced costs and improved communication. Joint activities and ministries have fostered greater interaction and engagement across parishes. Further savings and efficiencies may be realized through consolidating buildings and resources.

### 6. Campus Inventory & Deferred Maintenance

A comprehensive inventory of buildings and assets has been developed. Deferred maintenance does not currently pose a significant burden relative to parish revenues, and no major financial gaps have been identified at this time.

### 7. Mass Attendance and Site Utilization

Mass attendance, while showing some localized growth (e.g., St. Augustine's 40% increase), remains low relative to capacity. Could the underutilization suggest opportunities to consolidate resources and encourage fuller participation at fewer sites?



## 8. Demographic and Geographic Analysis

The parish territory is characterized by increasing diversity, with substantial Black American, Hispanic/Latino, and African immigrant populations. Many parishioners live outside canonical boundaries, reflecting broad regional connections.

- **Average age is rising** (from 39.16 in 2020 to a projected 41.36 in 2030).
- **Population trends:** School-age children and adults 55–64 are declining; adults 65+ are increasing.
- **Socioeconomic factors:** Projected income growth may not reflect local realities, particularly for Black Americans, who face higher unemployment rates.

The Family's ability to serve the Gospel mission will depend on embracing diversity, appreciating cultural differences in worship, and responding to demographic changes with inclusive outreach.

## 9. Temporal Resources and Strategic Planning

- **Sustainability:** Financially, the Family is stable together but not individually; much stability has come from previous property sales and investments. What do we do to increase giving?
- **Ministerial capacity:** Current ministries are largely maintained by volunteers. Additional staff would improve outreach, formation, and communication.
- **Resource reallocation:** Consideration is being given to selling or renting underused properties, such as the Queen of Martyrs school building and St Augustine Rectory.

## 10. SWOT Analysis: Canonical Unification & Beacons of Light

### Strengths:

- Active ministries (Bible studies, outreach, worship).
- Growing diversity and practical, business-minded stewardship.
- Unity has fostered strong collaboration and resource sharing.

### Weaknesses:

- Difficulty adapting to change for some parishioners.
- Need to increase participation in liturgical ministries.

### Opportunities:

- Leverage diversity for evangelization and community outreach.
- Expand support for aging parishioners and increase youth engagement.

### Threats:

- Ongoing aging of the parish population.
- Underrepresentation of younger families and the need for greater inclusivity for immigrant communities.

## 11. Recommendations: Future Organization & Resource Use

### Organizational Structure:

Canonical merger is recommended to maximize unity, resource efficiency, and mission effectiveness. Redundant or non-critical buildings should be eliminated or repurposed.

### Resource Allocation:

- Increase involvement of deacons and lay leaders to offset limited priest availability.
- Continue integrating leadership across all parishes.
- Focus on engaging younger parishioners and embracing the diversity of the Family.

### Conclusion

The Holy Spirit Family of Parishes is well-positioned to fulfill its vision and the Beacons of Light mission through continued unification, strategic resource management, and inclusive evangelization. With thoughtful planning and adaptation, the Family can ensure long-term vitality, financial health, and robust Gospel witness within its diverse and dynamic community.






