SAINT 'THINGS TO KNOW'

Parents of John the Baptist
Most common for the words of the "Hail Mary"

Priest and Doctor of the Church
Provides miraculous recoveries of lost items and guidance in spiritual

Also known as 'The Little Flower'
Celebrated profound spirituality and devotion to God through the "Little Way"
Honored as Doctor of the Church, taught on divine love and the simplicity of faith

Known for generosity and care for the poor
Inspires gift-giving in both Western and Eastern traditions

Also called Didymus ("twin"), one of the Twelve Apostles
Remembered for honest doubt and confession: "My Lord and my God" (John 20:28)

Bishop and Doctor of the Church
Writer, theologian, and mystic. Describes himself as 'servant of God'

Apostles shaping early Christianity
Pillars of faith, courage, and sacrifice

Patron of animals
Known for his humility, prayerful life, and founding of the Franciscan order

Spouse of Virgin Mary and foster father of Jesus
Model of paternal care, humility, and protection

First man and woman created by God
Their error was disobedience and cause of original sin

Patron of charities
Dedicated his long life to tireless works of charity, caring for the poor and suffering
