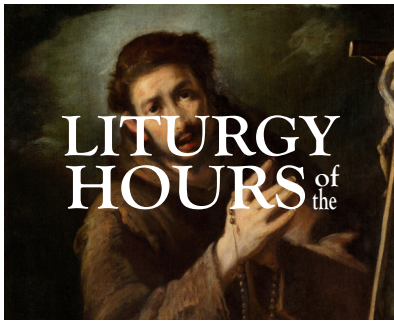

That They All May Be One

“Communion” implies that we are brought together to do something in common, not just individuals gathered to do the same thing at the same time. In the midst of our modern world, Christians are continuously called to come together; to value community, to be one; the mystery of the Incarnation demands more than just virtual “presence” on a screen. Gathered at the altar, the Eucharistic celebration is the primary way the Church comes together so that she may be sent forth to manifest God’s love to the world.

The celebration of the Eucharist, especially on Sundays, is “the source and summit of the Christian life”; thus, I echo the voices of bishops down through the ages, calling for the Eucharist to be the priority of every parish community, and therefore worth our continuing reflection, effort, and participation.

The excerpt above is from Archbishop Casey's first Pastoral Letter "That They All May Be One". At the end of the introduction, two questions are asked:

1. In what ways do I experience Sunday Mass as the "source and summit" of my life? Of my parishes life?
2. What opportunities are there for greater healing of division in our Church? In our world? What part can I play?

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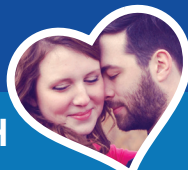
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
